



The Bishop blessed our new building and renovation and joined us for dinner and a speaker. It was a wonderful celebration and it was great to see our newly renovated Hall filled with parishioners enjoying food and fellowship with one another. A big thank you to the Altar Society, the Hispanic community, and the Micronesian community for all the wonderful food, the Legion of Mary for contacting parishioners and getting the word out, and the Knights of Columbus who worked to get everything set up and helped with clean up. Status of Building Fund

Miraculously, with many early donations and a \$253K loan made from parish savings, a diocesan loan was not needed to fund the renovation of the parish hall and construction of the church entrance addition which are both essentially complete. A few final touches are planned.

Available cash for parish operation is low, but should be sufficient as time passes and donations are received over the five year payment period. \$20K is currently in the Building Fund account which should be able to go toward the parish loan.

Also, a \$769.50 check was recently received from the chancery for another half of the overage of the Rooted in Faith - Forward in Hope diocesan capital campaign. Thus far, \$18K was received for the parish share and \$17K for half of the overage of the campaign. These funds have been deposited in the Building Fund. Thanks to all who have contributed to a marvelous project.



Virtus Clarification

We learned this past week concerning the update of the *Virtus* training that only those who have not completed *Virtus* training within the past five years are in need of training with the new material that is available on-line at the diocesan website. <https://www.virtusonline.org/virtus>

Administrator Kay Walser is notifying those whose past training is in need of update, including a few catechists. All parish adults are encouraged to become covered volunteers with *Virtus* training, background check (even if undocumented, since the check is for Church use only), and agreement with diocesan policies. Let us all do our part to respond to Bishop's plea for all to become allies by establishing a parish that is committed to the protection of children and adults and dedicated to limiting the likelihood of abuse occurring or continuing within our community. God has created each of us in His image and likeness.
